

FOOD CONCESSION VENDORS

FLORIDA STATE STATUTE 633.0215, FLORIDA FIRE PREVENTION CODE

- (1) The State Fire Marshal shall adopt, by rule pursuant to FSS 120.536(1) and 120.54, the Florida Fire Prevention Code which shall contain or incorporate by reference all fire safety laws and rules that pertain to and govern the design, construction, erection, alteration, modification, repair, and demolition of public and private buildings, structures, and facilities and the enforcement of such fire safety laws and rule. The State Fire Marshal shall adopt a new edition of the Florida Fire Prevention Code every third year.

In accordance with the above stated Florida State Statute and the adopted Florida Uniform Fire Code, NO CONCESSION WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE PREMISES IF COOKING EQUIPMENT INSIDE ANY TYPE OF ROOFED ENCLOSURE DOES NOT CONTAIN AN EXHAUST SYSTEM AND FIRE SUPPRESSION SYSTEM THAT COMPLIES WITH NFPA 96 AND HAS A CURRENT STATE INSPECTION TAG AFFIXED BY A FLORIDA STATE LICENSED FIRE SUPPRESSION CONTRACTOR.

UNIFORM FLORIDA FIRE CODE, 50.2.1.9: Cooking equipment used in fixed, mobile, or temporary concessions, such as trucks, buses, trailers, pavilions, tents, or any form of roofed enclosure, shall comply with NFPA 96 or this chapter.

UNIFORM FLORIDA FIRE CODE, 50.4.3.2: Cooking equipment that produces grease-laden vapors and that might be a source of ignition of grease in the hood, grease removal device, or duct shall be protected by fire extinguishing equipment.

UNIFORM FLORIDA FIRE CODES 10.11.6 and 10.15.8: No hibachi, gas-fired grill, charcoal grill, or other similar devices used for cooking, heating, or any other purpose shall be used or kindled within 10 feet of any structure. Concession stands or tents shall not be located within 10 feet of any structure.
